

SATs Results 2016

The Year Six pupils in 2016 were the first to take the new tests based on the most recent National Curriculum. Not only were the tests quite different in style and more challenging, but the way the results were reported was completely different.

Previously, children had been given levels of attainment according to how many marks they scored in each test, for example level 4b, 5c, 5a etc. This year, for the first time, there were no levels. Instead children were judged as either achieving the expected standard or not.
